

COMMON EXPECTATIONS OF STUDENTS

The following expectations play a significant role in the development of the College spirit as outlined by the College Mission Statement.

All students who enrol at Newman College make a commitment to:

1. be courteous and to conduct themselves, both verbally and physically, in such a way that they demonstrate respect for others - staff, students and themselves
2. follow promptly and politely instructions given by staff and other adults
3. respect the rights of others in order to contribute to a friendly, safe and secure learning environment for all
4. respect their own property, the property of others and College property
5. respect the College environment
6. participate actively and positively in the co-curricular programme offered by the College and to represent the College according to their level of ability
7. wear the College uniform, completely and neatly in order to reflect pride in themselves and in the College
8. accept responsibility for their own health, hygiene and physical well being
9. attend all scheduled classes and activities (eg camps, carnivals) that are scheduled during College time
10. attempt all set work, class and homework, to the best of their ability
11. be punctual at all times
12. be properly prepared and equipped for all classes and/or activities
13. enter a classroom or any other College facility only when a teacher is present
